Dr. Shay Pilnik is the Executive Director of the Nathan and Ether Pelz Holocaust Education Resource Center in Milwaukee (HERC). He earned his Bachelor's degree from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, majoring in Comparative Literature and Jewish Thought. He continued his academic training at McGill University in Montreal, where he graduated with an MA in Jewish Studies, specializing in East European Jewish Culture. In the fall of 2005, he began a Ph.D. program at the Jewish Theological Seminary in the field of Modern Jewish Studies. He defended his doctoral dissertation in the spring of 2013, dealing with the commemoration of the Holocaust in the Soviet Union. From 2008-2014, he was an adjunct instructor at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, and the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, lecturing on a variety of topics including modern Jewish history, the Holocaust, and the religions of the world. He joined the HERC team in the summer of 2014.
