he came down from heaven,

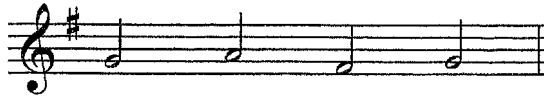
*[all bow] and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary,

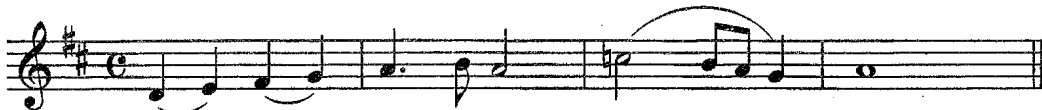
