## PROFESSION OF FAITH

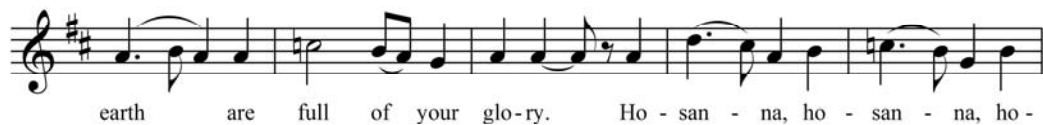
