Parish Business:

- Life Touch –Parish Directory-Christopher

- Cathedral Center update-Paula Johnson and Donna Rongholt-Migan
 - Update provided on the activities and accomplishments of the Cathedral Center.
- Bishop's Update
 - Plan for Emergency Response Procedures-Committee is set to meet and the Archdiocesan guidelines have been shared. The Cathedral will be a pilot parish for a free security assessment as offered by a security company partnering with the Archdioceses.
 - St. Vincent De Paul reentry program for formerly incarcerated women and men has begun their lease and will be beginning to offer their programs soon.
 - Archdiocese is participating in a pilot program, as a result of a Lilly grant, with Catholic Leadership Institute. The services provided use a data informed/mission driven model.

Parishes and clergy throughout the Archdiocese will be asked to participate in data collection/surveys to identify our collective strengths and weaknesses. Cathedral parishioners will be asked to participate by taking the “Disciple Maker Index,” which is a standard 75 question survey, available in 13 languages. A committee of parishioners is needed to take on the logistics of the project. The goal is for the survey to be shared with parishioners during lent.

- Fr. Jose’s Update
 - Holy Hour/Adoration is held once a month, and is in English and Spanish
 - Young Adult group is celebrating their one-year anniversary. Four member of the group will be traveling to El Paso to minster at the border.
 - Rosary is held once a month at the clinic on Farwell
 - Formation continues once a month in Spanish
