

In ancient Israel, pilgrims were expected to appear in Jerusalem to celebrate the Feasts of Passover (Pesach), Weeks (Shavuot) and Tabernacles (Sukkot). To ready themselves for their appearance at the temple, a cycle of fifteen Psalms developed to assist people in the spiritual preparation for the ascent to Jerusalem from all parts of ancient Israel. Psalms 120 to 134 are known in today's psalter as the Songs of Ascent. We will explore the themes of these Psalms of Ascent in comparison to our own preparations for the liturgical season of Advent as modern pilgrims awaiting the descent of the Messiah.
